

The Eastern Nursing Research Society would like to congratulate several of our members who were recently inducted as Fellows of The American Academy of Nursing.

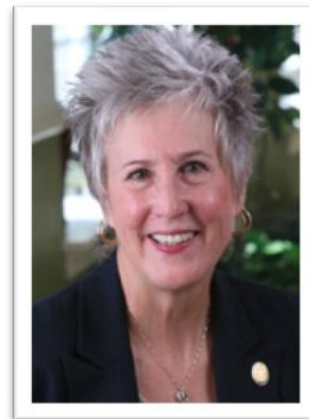
