

ENRS Abstract Submission Information for Individual School Selected Student Poster Presentations

Please note that the deadline to begin a new submission is 11/10/2017 12:00 PM - Noon EST.

The Eastern Nursing Research Society is pleased to accept abstracts to be considered for presentation at the ENRS 30th Annual Scientific Sessions. This year's theme is ***Celebrating 30 Years of Nursing Science: Building a Legacy of Innovation, Dissemination and Translation***. The conference will be April 11-13, 2018 at the Newark Liberty International Airport Marriott, 1 Hotel Rd, Newark, NJ 07114 .

The objectives for the ENRS 30th Annual Scientific Sessions are:

1. Examine innovative programs of research in which nursing perspectives have made significant contributions to advancing the quality of care to individuals, families and communities.
2. Propose innovative strategies for dissemination and translation of nursing science into practice.
3. Explore theoretical and methodological perspectives of nursing science including dissemination and translation of nursing science into practice.

Description of the 30th Annual Scientific Sessions:

The 30th Annual Scientific Sessions appeals to all individuals interested in advancing nursing science, including practicing nurse researchers and dedicated nursing science students and faculty.

Individual School's Selected Student Poster Presentations

ENRS offers nursing students a great opportunity to share emerging scholarship by presenting a poster at the 30th Annual Scientific Sessions. We invite individual schools and institutions to select and submit these student poster abstracts, which will NOT be peer-reviewed through November 10, 2017.

***There is no fee for submitting these abstracts.**

Each university/college is invited to submit a maximum of:

- One abstract representing project work of BS students
- One abstract representing project work of MS students
- One abstract representing the dissertation topic of doctoral students who have not yet defended their proposal*
- One abstract representing the project of DNP students*

**An institution that has a PhD program OR a DNP program, but not both programs, may submit a maximum of two abstracts for the respective category.*

Please note, it is the responsibility of each university/college, and not the students, to select and submit the poster abstracts.

General Instructions

1. **All abstracts must be submitted by November 10, 2017 12:00 PM Noon. No extensions!**
2. An acceptance letter will be sent by email to the lead author on or around December 8, 2017. Presenters must confirm their participation by December 15, 2017.
3. Abstracts selected for the program, as originally submitted, will be sent for publication in the Nursing Research Journal. **No edits to abstract content will be granted after submissions are finalized.**

4. Once selected for the program, authors will have an opportunity to review and make necessary minor edits (i.e. spelling, author credentials, etc.) to their submission for inclusion in the ENRS 30th Annual Scientific Sessions Book of Proceedings. **All revisions will be due by December 21, 2017; no edits will be granted after this date.**
5. **A note about word counts:** All abstracts will be limited to 2,500 characters (including spaces), approximately 300 words.
